Abstract

Questo manoscritto rivedrà l'essenza del ruolo della CO₂ nell'atmosfera terrestre. La logica del coinvolgimento della CO₂ nel cambiamento del clima sarà studiata da ogni prospettiva: rivedere il record dei dati storici, esaminare più dettagliatamente il record di dati del XX secolo e valutare il ruolo della radiazione di CO₂ nell'atmosfera, calcolando e integrando il Equazione di radiazione di Schwarzschild con un complemento completo di coefficienti di assorbimento di CO₂. Viene fornita una revisione della nuova teoria del cambiamento climatico, dovuta al campo magnetico del Sole che interagisce con i raggi cosmici. L'applicazione di questa nuova teoria è applicata agli eventi di cambiamento climatico all'interno dell'ultima parte del periodo interglaciale della Terra. L'applicazione dell'età fredda terrestre non è dettagliata in questo studio a causa dei vincoli delle dimensioni del manoscritto, ma viene fatto riferimento per il lettore.

I risultati di questa revisione indicano il valore estremo della CO₂ per tutte le forme di vita, ma nessun ruolo della CO₂ in nessun cambiamento significativo del clima della Terra.

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
